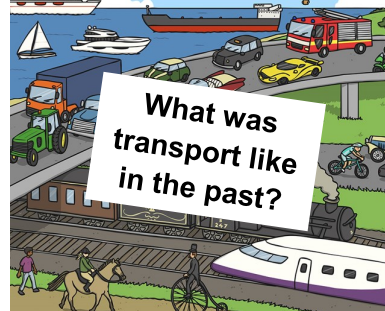
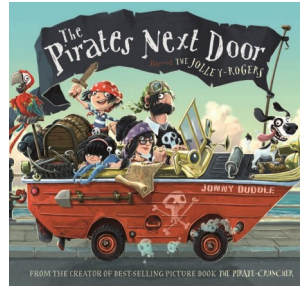


REMINDERS

Year 2 Spring 2 2022 Term Newsletter



As **READERS** we will be:

Continuing to practise phonics using the Read Write inc to develop our reading and taking part in whole-class guided reading sessions.

We will be clarifying, making predictions and summarising books.

Our text this half-term is the picture book, 'The Pirates next door' about a pirate family (The Jolley-Rogers) moving to Dull-on-Sea.

In **R.E.** we will be:

Continuing to explore 'Believing' in different faiths and observing similarities and differences between the faiths.

We will also be thinking about our own beliefs and how we can respect the beliefs of others.

As **MATHEMATICIANS** we will:

Learn about Shape and addition and subtraction.

We will learn about polygons and different ways to sort them using the terms sides, vertex and vertices. We will also look at 3-D shapes and how these can be sorted.

We will learn to add and subtract 2 digit numbers from one another and start to do so by 'crossing 10'.

As **WRITERS** we will be:

Writing a 'cinquain' poem using personification, writing our own 'action story' and developing our letter writing skills.

We'll be continuing to use capital letters, full stops and finger spaces, as well as exploring commas for lists and apostrophes for possession.

In **Science** we will be:

Continuing to learn about animals including humans. We will name the different groups of animals (mammals, birds etc..) and compare their features.

We'll look at the basic needs of animals for survival, as well as the importance of exercise and nutrition for humans and linking this to growth.

In **History** we will be:

Investigating transport through time focusing on the lives of significant people such as Amy Johnson, Yuri Gagarin, Neil Armstrong and Captain Scott.

We'll also see how they have contributed towards our national achievements.

In **Design and Technology** we will be:

Using our knowledge of structures and textiles to design and build a model boat.

We'll learn the features of a boat and their different purposes, identify a purpose for their boat before designing and making it.
