As **READERS** we will be:

Developing our phonics through RWI.

Reading "The Wild Way Home." by Sophie Kirtley. This is a time slip novel, switching between our time and the Stone Age.

We will also have time to read for pleasure and to listen to an adult reading to us.

In **RW** we will be:

Studying the unit "Remembering." We will think about how we remember and celebrate key events and also learn how members of Faith groups demonstrate remembrance.

(RW, Religion and World Views, is the subject previously known as RE)

As **MATHEMATICIANS** we will be:

Extending our knowledge of the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

We will start to measure using a metre ruler.

We will learn to compare and order 3-digit numbers.

We will develop our ability to add and subtract mentally including adding and subtracting 1s, 10s and 100s

In **GEOGRAPHY** we will be:

Developing our maths skills so we can identify the different continents and the northern and southern hemispheres.
