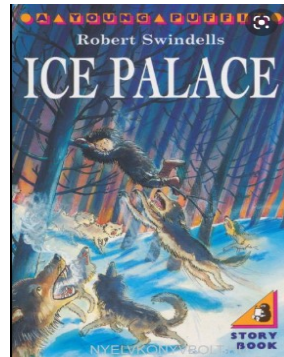


## REMINDERS
