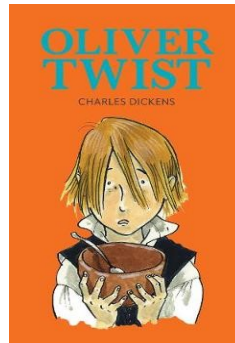


## REMINDERS

As **MATHEMATICIANS** we will be:

Learning about dividing two and 3 digit numbers by one digit numbers.

We will use partitioning and representations before moving on to formal written methods.
