As **MATHEMATICIANS** we will:

In maths we will be finishing off learning about position and direction.

We will then be learning about doubling and halving in multiplication and division.

Finally, we will learning about capacity, mass and measure.

As **WRITERS** we will be:

In poetry we will be looking at performance poetry.

In our fiction writing we will be looking at stories with a moral and writing our own stories with a moral.

Finally in non-fiction we will be studying first person recounts.

As **READERS** we will be:

In guided reading we will be reading a selection of fiction and non fiction texts and answering a range of questions about the texts.

During our English lessons our text will be *Amazing Grace* by Mary Hoffmann.

In **History** we will be:

Asking Where did Amy Johnson fly? And looking at the history of mechanical flight.

Learning about Amy Johnson's life, her achievements and her legacy following her pioneering career in flight.

In **Science** we will be:

Observing and describing how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.

We will be finding out and describing how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

In **R.E.** we will be:

Thinking about 'Believing' by looking at key figures from the Old and New Testaments, alongside stories from other religious traditions; focusing on key beliefs demonstrated in the stories and the commitments that stem from those beliefs.

In **Design & Technology** we will be:

We will be designing, sewing and evaluating napkins to take on a picnic to the beach.

We will study a variety of sewing techniques like the running stitch and the whip stitch.
