On Friday 20th October we will be celebrating Harvest Festival at 2.30pm and would love you to join us in the school hall. Further information can be found in the newsletter.

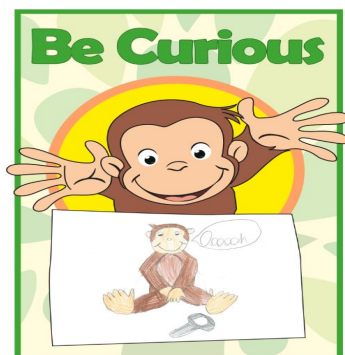

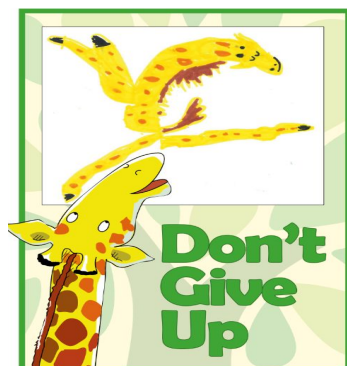

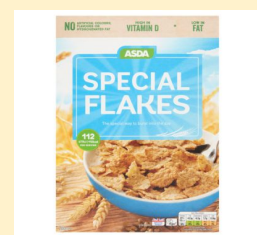




Harvest Festival

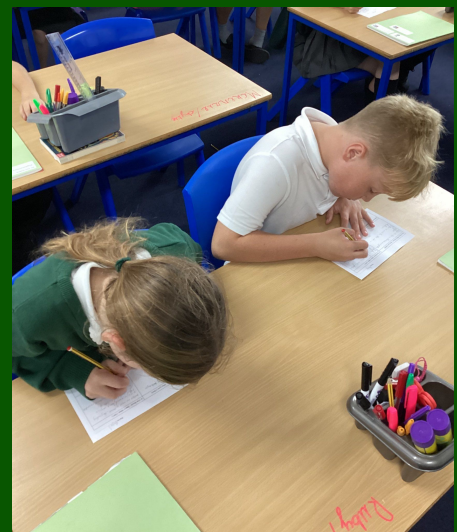

- bed wetting and toileting issues,
- sleep and behaviour difficulties,
- growing up and puberty issues,
- health conditions

I can do: -

- hearing and growth checks,
- liaise with health services and make referrals,
- write health care plans for school,
- advise and support on health conditions,
- advise parents where they need to go for support - support parents with any health concerns or emotional wellbeing issues such as anxiety, emotional or mood issues and behaviour.
