In **LIFE SKILLS** we will be:

- Visiting the shops each week to buy the ingredients for our cookery sessions.
- Taking part in cookery sessions weekly, learning how to work safely and reading and following instructions.
- Visiting the library and borrowing books each week.

As **READERS** we will be:

Developing our phonics through RWI.
Reading regularly to an adult in school.
Choosing books to read for pleasure at the library.
Having stories read to us on a daily basis.
